

Rajampet, A.P on 3rd, 4th and 5th June, 2011**



Annamacharya College of Pharmacy, Rajampet managed by Annamacharya Educational Trust was established about eight years ago, is one of the well known established institutions in the region. At present it offers B. Pharm and M. Pharm programs.

All team members arrived on June 2nd in the afternoon. Preliminary discussion with all the team members was held at place of stay on June 2nd at 7 p.m.

The tentative visit schedule was made as per the AICTE visit schedule exactly to timely manner with in depth visit to all central facilities including central library, central computer centre, workshop, Physics, Chemistry labs, Medical facility, Canteen facility, Students' hostels, Sports facility, T & P facility. The team members further met with students, staff, teaching faculty, parents, alumni and employers. The visit was concluded after an exit meeting on day 3rd i.e. on 5th June, 2011 at 10 a.m. wherein the chairman detailed the strengths and the weakness of the program to the management.

The committee thoroughly inspected and visited the infrastructure facilities of the college. The committee further verified the documents related to accreditation. It is therefore recommended in an unanimous basis that Annamacharya College of Pharmacy, Rajampet, A.P may be given accreditation for a period of three years.
